WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

You finish building your website so a stranger can understand it easily. You check headings, menus and actions on your own pages. Then you visit a classmate's site on their screen and say one thing that works well and one thing that was hard to find.

- Complete a multi-page website ensuring it is clear and functional for visitors.
- Evaluate their own site from the perspective of a first-time user.
- Visit a peer's website independently and give specific feedback: one strength and one thing that was hard to find.
