In this lesson you will type HTML code by hand on a practice page. You will change text inside tags, add new tags, put one tag inside another, and fix errors when the page breaks.

- Understand the function of opening and closing tags in HTML.
- Learn to identify and correct syntax errors in HTML markup.
- Put one tag inside another to make a word stand out.
