ANSWERS

1 · Write it five ways

- Book — Irish Leabhar · French le livre · German das Buch · Spanish el libro
- Pencil — Irish Peann luaidhe · French le crayon · German der Bleistift · Spanish el lápiz

2 · Find what they share

- Open answer — Accept any two the child can justify, with the shared letters. Mark the reason, not the pair. No close pair: "none" is right.

3 · What you can do now

- Open answer — Ticks are the child's own judgement, not a test. The written fourth line is the one to read.
