ANSWERS

1 · The pieces inside the names

- tulach — a hill or mound
- mór — big or great

2 · Find your piece inside a real name

- Tullamore — tulach — a hill or mound
(whole name: Great Hill / Big Mound)

3 · Name a place yourself

- Open answer — Any name built from something really there, with its meaning given. Accept English spelling of the Irish piece.
