ANSWERS

1 • Write it five ways

- Yellow — Irish Buí • French jaune • German gelb • Spanish amarillo
- Green — Irish Glas • French vert • German grün • Spanish verde
- Orange — Irish Oráiste • French orange • German orange • Spanish naranja

2 • Find what they share

- Open answer — Accept any two the child can justify, with the shared letters. Mark the reason, not the pair. No close pair: “none” is right.

3 • What you can do now

- Open answer — Ticks are the child's own judgement, not a test. The written fourth line is the one to read.
