1 • Write it five ways

- Hand — Irish Lámh • French la main • German die Hand • Spanish la mano
- Nose — Irish Srón • French le nez • German die Nase • Spanish la nariz
- Arm — Irish Géag • French le bras • German der Arm • Spanish el brazo

2 • Find what they share

- Open answer — Accept any two the child can justify, with the shared letters. Mark the reason, not the pair. No close pair: “none” is right.

3 • What you can do now

- Open answer — Ticks are the child's own judgement, not a test. The written fourth line is the one to read.
