1 · The pieces inside the names

- cill — church
- teampall — a church building

2 · Find your piece inside a real name

- Kilkenny — cill — church (whole name: Church of Cainnech)
- Killarney — cill — church (whole name: Church of the Sloes)
- Kildare — cill — church (whole name: Church of the Oak)
- Kilrush — cill — church (whole name: Church of the Peninsula)

3 · Name a place yourself

- Open answer — Any name built from something really there, with its meaning given. Accept English spelling of the Irish piece.
