WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

In this step-by-step lesson, you'll create an interactive LED stack using a Microbit project. You'll add the neopixel extension, set up the LED strip, create variables, and develop functions to control the LED stack. By programming buttons, you'll be able to increase or decrease the stack. Finally, you'll download your code and test your LED stack.

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO

- Develop skills in creating and managing a new Microbit project.
- Understand and apply the neopixel extension for LED programming.
- Learn to set up and interact with the LED strip using variables.
- Develop competency in creating and using functions to control LED display.
- Gain experience in programming button controls to manipulate LED stack size.
