

Brainstorming Blast

60 minutes

Coding and Creative Projects

WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

This lesson is designed to encourage creativity and teamwork among students. They will brainstorm ideas for a simple Scratch project, receive feedback, and start working on their projects in groups.

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO

- Students will understand the process of brainstorming and how it can be used to generate creative ideas for projects.
- Students will develop teamwork skills, including active listening, respectful communication, and collaborative decision-making.
- Students will apply their knowledge of Scratch programming to conceptualize and plan a simple project.
- Students will gain experience in presenting their ideas to a group and giving and receiving constructive feedback.
- Students will develop problem-solving skills as they implement their project ideas in Scratch.
- Students will reflect on their learning process, recognizing how their original ideas evolved through implementation and feedback.
