WHAT THIS LESSON DOES

In this lesson we will learn about some of the tools we can use to create computer art and create our own character.

WHAT STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO DO

- Students will understand how to navigate and use the Scratch website to create digital art.
- Students will learn how to use the costumes editor in Scratch to modify existing sprites.
- Students will develop skills in using different graphic design tools such as the paint bucket tool, select tool, reshape tool, circle tool, rectangle tool, and line tool.
- Students will be able to apply their knowledge of these tools to change the color, shape, and size of different parts of a sprite.
- Students will learn how to add new shapes to a sprite, such as circles, squares, and lines.
- Students will demonstrate their understanding and skills by creating their own character using the tools and techniques learned in the lesson.
